Our mission is to provide community service to animal shelters, rescues and to other animals in need, through raising public awareness, fundraisers, donation drives and club activity events

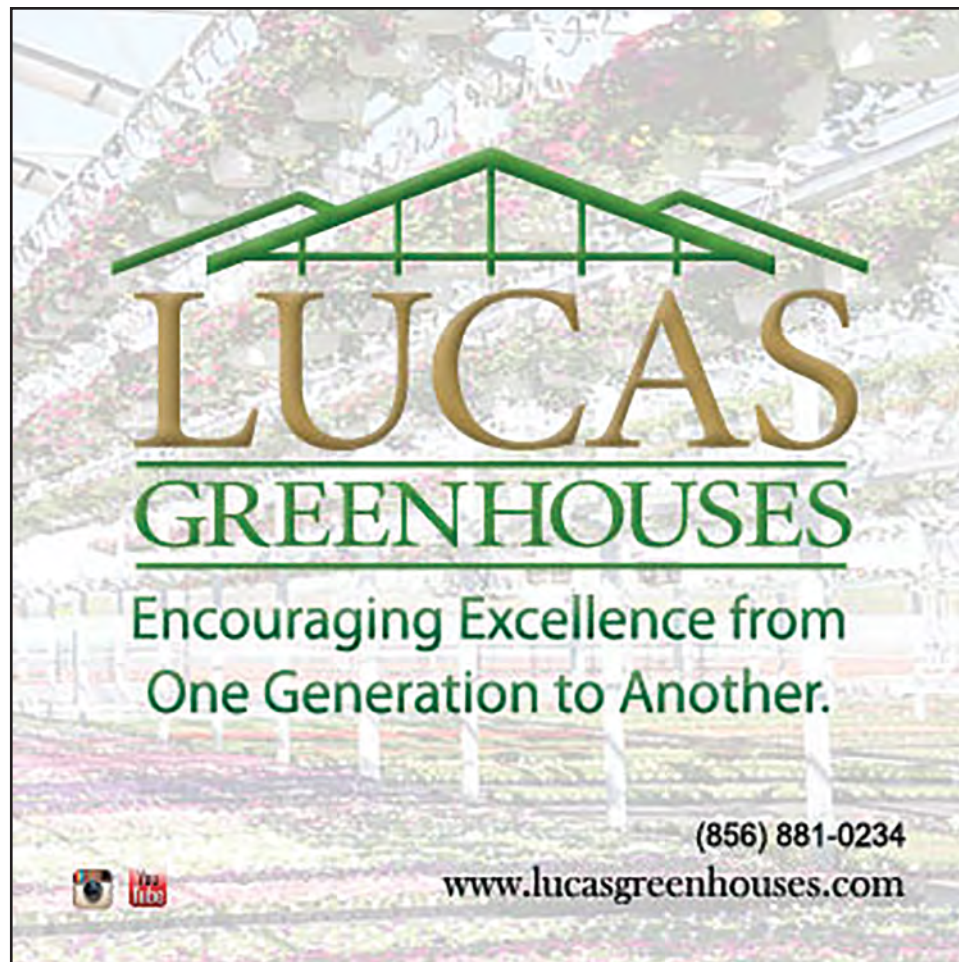


Some past projects include:

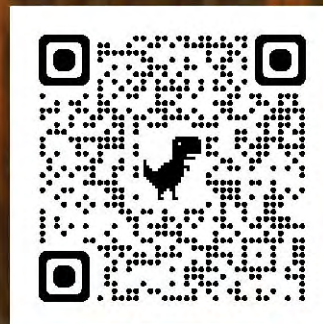

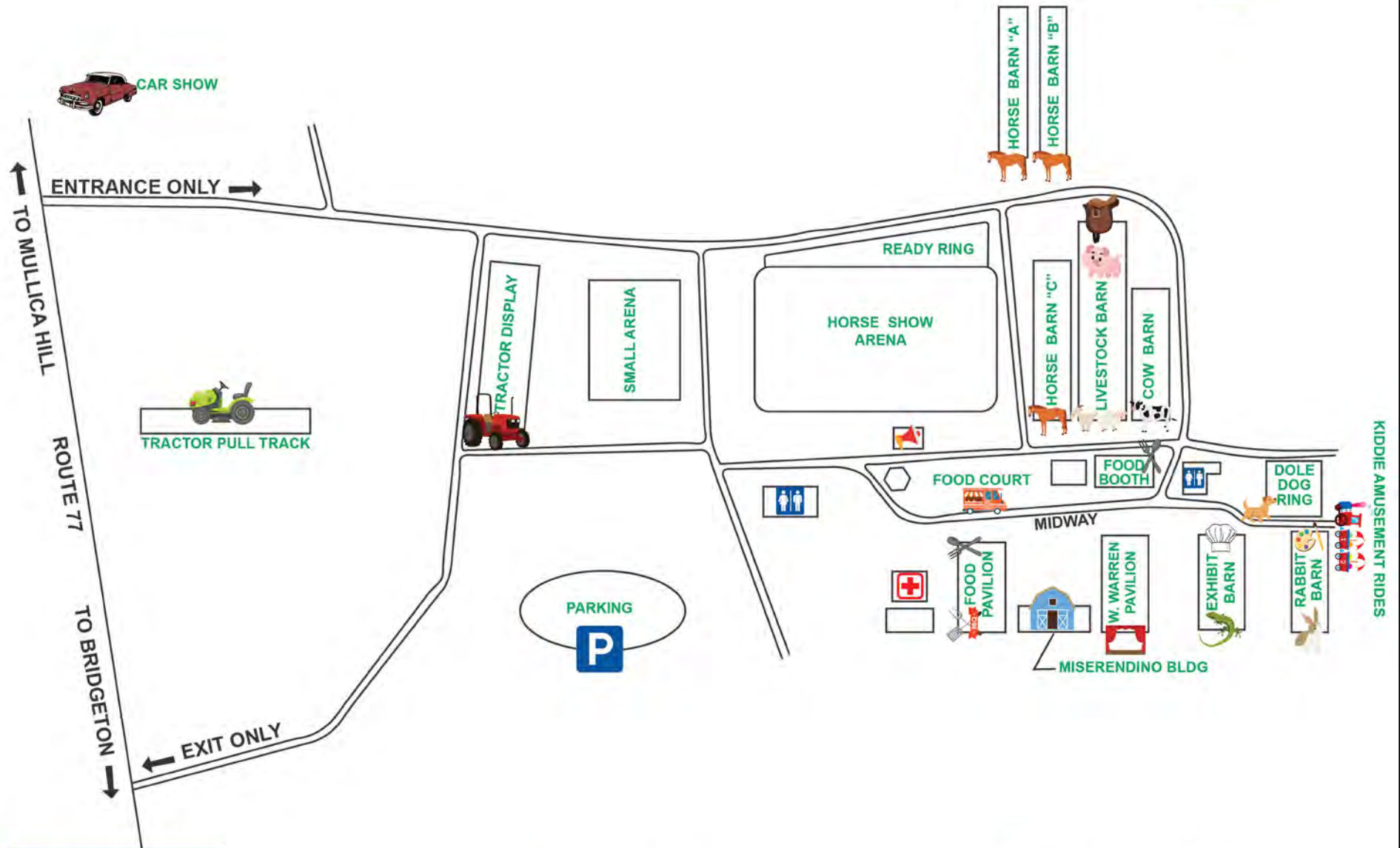

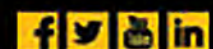
