Awards will be given in each category of each age group. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awards will be awarded in the Youth classes, Adult class & Pet class. (Participants in grades K-3rd will recive a participantion award.)

#### Rules:

- Artwork must be animal (domesticated, wild, exotic, or insect) related!
- Categories are Photography, Visual Art, Craft, or Pet
- Age divisions within each category (except pet) are K-3rd, 4th-7th, 8th-13th & Adult
- All Photos must be framed! They may be cropped. However, if any other adjustments are made (color, brightness, contrast, retouch etc.), include an original photo marked "original" when piece is submitted.
- 2D Art must be framed, matted or on canvas!
- All entries need an entry card with exhibitor's information (name, phone number, and grade) category (Photography, Visual Art, Craft, or Pet), class, and title.
- No more than 3 entries per category per person or pet.
- No kits allowed!
- Artwork that has been previously entered in the Helping Paws Animal Art show can NOT be entered again!!
- Artwork must be entered under the name of the person who created the piece!
- Artwork must be picked up no later than 2:00pm!

In this jumping competition, dogs will take turns jumping over a bar jump. Each turn they take, the jump will be higher. If the dog knocks over the bar, they are out.





#### **DIVISION CHAMPIONS: GRAND & RESERVE**

**4-H EQUITATION DIVISION** Open to 4-H members in grades 4-13 as of Sept. of previous year. Judged on general equitation hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences will be 2'6".

**OPEN EQUITATION DIVISION** Open to riders in grades 4 and over. Judged on general equitation hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences will be 2'6".

**LOW HUNTER DIVISION** Open to riders in grade 4 and over. Fences will be 2'6. No cross-entering into divisions with lower fence heights.

**CHILDREN'S/ADULT EQUITATION DIVISION** Open to riders in grade 4 and over. Horses or Ponies. Fences will be 2'3".

**OTTB HUNTER DIVISION** Open to riders with OTTB that have jockey papers or tattoo# at registration. If paperwork is not available, the show staff will make the final determination. To be judged on performance and soundness with special emphasis on manners and suitability. Excessive speed will be penalized.

**LOW GREEN HUNTER DIVISION** Open to riders in grade 4 and over with horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Fences will be 2'. Horse or Ponies may trot corners without being penalized. Cannot ride in classes with higher fence heights.

**SHORT STIRRUP EQ DIVISION** Open to riders in grade 4 to 6. Fences will be cross rails. To be judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount.

**BEGINNER RIDER** Open to riders in grade 4 to 13. Riders must be in their 1st or 2nd year of showing.

CLOVERBUD / LEADLINE Open to riders age 6 through grade 3.

**ENGLISH PLEASURE DIVISION** Open to riders in grade 4 and over. To be judged with emphasis on manners and suitability, as well as soundness and performance. Must back readily and stand quietly. NO MARTINGALES.

**LONG STIRRUP DIVISION** Open to riders 18 years of age or over. To be judged on hands, seat, general appearance and control of mount.
